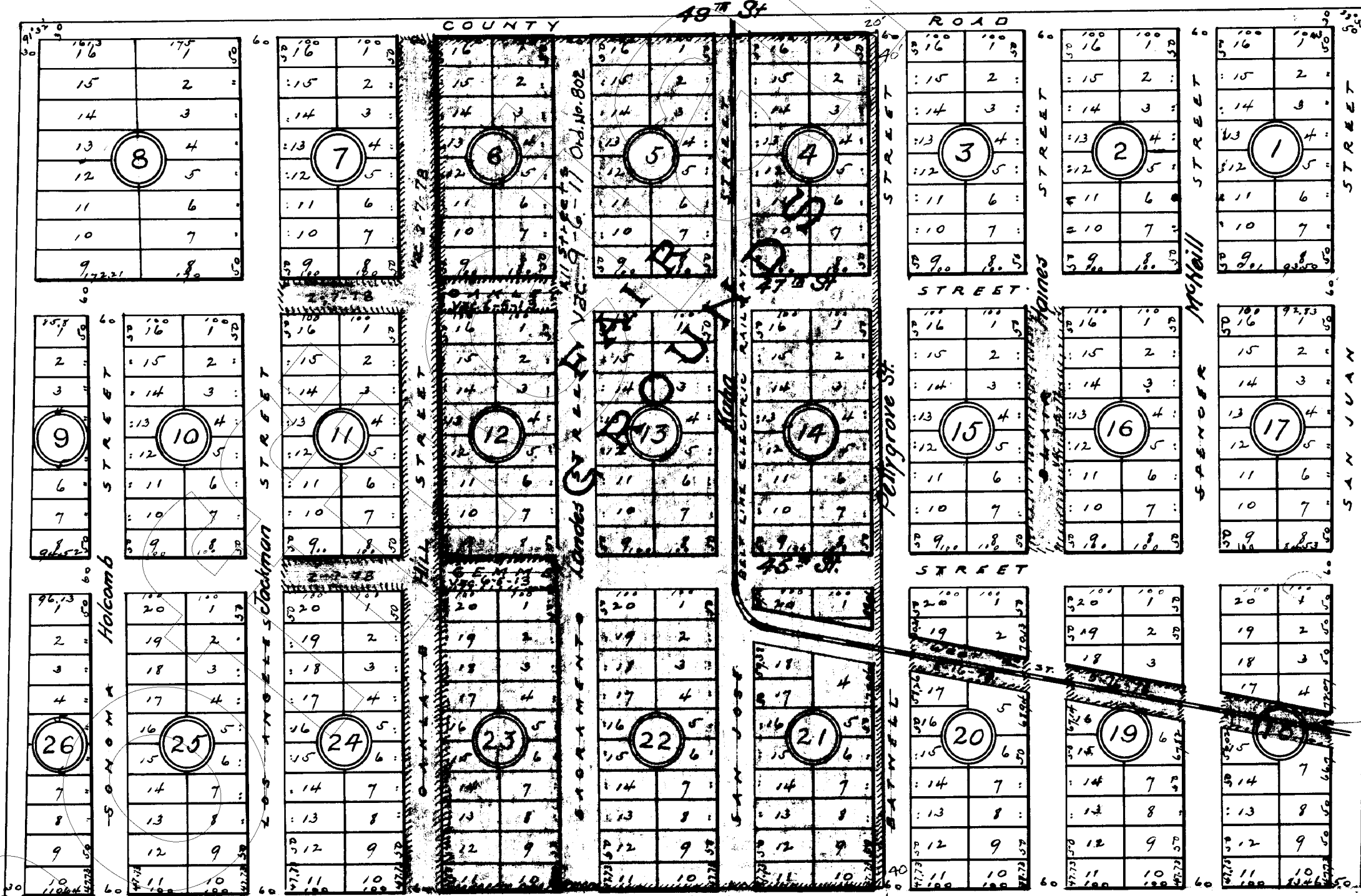


# Bracken's Addition

### Description.

This Bracken's Addition to Port Townsend and Wash. is situated in the S.E. 1/4 of Sec 34 Twp 31 Range 17 is a part of what is known as the Bracken tract and is more minutely described as follows: Commencing at a point on the line between Sections 34 & 35 T. 31 R. 1 and (1004.91) feet North of the corner to Sections 34 & 35 Twp 30 R. 1 W. and 34 & 35 Twp 31 R. 1 W. thence North 1474.04 feet to 1/4 Sec. cor. thence West 2232.8 thence South (1478.04) feet and thence to place of beginning distant (1244.3) feet. Size of lots and width of Streets and Avenues are as marked on the face of this plat in feet.

### Dedication

Know all men by these presents that we Thomas Bracken and Mary Bracken husband and wife owners in full simple of the land embraced within and covered by the above description of Bracken's Addition to Port Townsend Wash. do hereby declare this plat, and do hereby dedicate to the use of the Public forever all streets and avenues as hereby laid out thereon.
